There are varieties
of gifts, but the
same spirit.



Today is the third of the series of Theophanies, Manifestations of Jesus as God.

FIRST READING: Isaiah has a word from the Lord that he must speak. It is a word of God's delight in his people, and of his desire to take his people to himself as his own special possession. May the message of God's delight in us reach deep into the heart of the Church and each of her members so that we may surrender ourselves into his embrace.

RESPONSORIAL: In today's psalm the Church responds to Isaiah's message of God's delight in us by proclaiming God's glory and kingship over all people.

SECOND READING: In 1Corinthians, Paul proclaims the one source and the one purpose of the gifts of Christian life and fellowship. Every spiritual gift is produced in us by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and is given to benefit not only the individual recipient, but the whole community of faith. Thus, gratitude and humble service ought to mark the lives of those who have received gifts from the hand of the Lord.

GOSPEL: The spousal imagery of God's love for his people in Isaiah finds echo in John's account of Jesus' first sign at Cana. Even though his hour has not yet come, Mary's faith in her Son becomes the occasion of his first sign of God's kingdom. Jesus turns water into wine, the fruit of the vine and work of human hands that brings joy to our hearts. Jesus' ministry begins with an act of joy and delight, a sign of God's desire for our relationship with him.

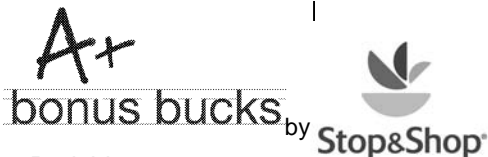

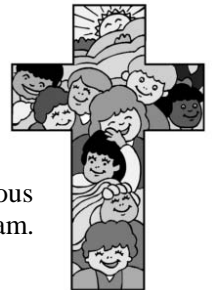
Religious Education News

Registration for Summer CCD

begins Tuesday, January 19th, 2010.

Forms may be downloaded from our website at stachurchbloomfield.com or may be completed in person at the Religious Education Office starting the 19th at 8:45am.

Please do NOT drop off the forms until 8:45am on the 19th or they will NOT be accepted – the school is closed on the 18th for the holiday. Please note that this program fills up very quickly and only completed registrations will be accepted. A completed registration package includes: a registration form, a behavior contract, and a volunteer sheet. All three forms must be handed in to begin processing the registration. If your child attended Summer CCD last year they are NOT automatically accepted into the program this summer. All completed registration forms MUST be dropped off ONLY in the Religious Education Office which is located in the basement of St. Thomas School. Registrations dropped off in the STA School Office or in the Parish Center will NOT be accepted. As always, volunteers are needed for all grades – especially grades 6 and 7.

FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION

THE HOLY NAME SOCIETY CONTINUES TO PROVIDE FREE FEDERAL AND NJ STATE INCOME TAX PREPARATION FOR SENIORS AND DISABLED MEMBERS OF ST. THOMAS THE APOSTLE PARISH. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS SERVICE, YOU MUST BE A REGISTERED MEMBER OF ST. THOMAS, AT LEAST 62 YEARS OF AGE OR DISABLED, NOT ACTIVELY EMPLOYED AND REQUIRE NO MORE FORMS AND SCHEDULES THAN THOSE LISTED BELOW.

INCOME TAX RETURNS WILL BE PREPARED BY EXPERIENCED TAX PREPARERS WHO ARE ACTIVE MEMBERS OF THE HOLY NAME SOCIETY, VOLUNTEERING THEIR TIME AND TALENT IN THE SPIRIT OF STEWARDSHIP.

INCOME TAX RETURNS WILL BE LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING FORMS AND SCHEDULES:

- FEDERAL FORMS 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ
- FEDERAL SCHEDULES A, B, D, E (RESIDENTIAL RENTAL ONLY), AND R.
- NJ STATE FORMS 1040NJ AND 1040NJHR
- NJ SCHEDULES B, C, AND HR-A

THE TAX PREPARATION PROCESS FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL OR MARRIED COUPLE WILL INCLUDE AN INTERVIEW, REVIEW OF YOUR 2008 TAX RETURN AND TURNOVER OF YOUR TAX DOCUMENTS (1099'S). COMPLETED RETURNS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN ABOUT ONE WEEK.

TAX PREPARERS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE PARISH CENTER EVERY FRIDAY FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 12:00 NOON BEGINNING FRIDAY, JANUARY 29, 2010.

IT WILL NOT BE NECESSARY TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT. COME IN TO THE PARISH CENTER TO GET YOUR TAXES DONE OR TO SPEAK TO A TAX PREPARER.
