Please plan now to join us for our first major sacred Advent concert by the choir in (at least) six years! Last December we gave a beautiful Medieval Advent Lessons and Carols Service, but we needed the space in the aisles that Immaculate Conception provided and so happily combined with their choir and a few instruments. This year, we have the opportunity to present a beloved Christmas work, Handel's "Messiah" Part 1, right here at St. Thomas. The choruses contain many of the prophecies (in our cycle B readings for Advent this year!) foretelling the birth of Christ, and take us through the Nativity as well. As tradition demands, we add the famous "Hallelujah" Chorus (actually the end of the Easter Part 2) to close the concert. If you've never heard this piece with a professional orchestra, this is your chance. It is truly a musical and spiritual experience you will never forget. You *will* forget about all the craziness that the secular world surrounds us with during these weeks, and you'll be filled with the *true* spirit of the season.

The St. Thomas Choir has been hard at work with extra rehearsals since August, and they are being joined by some members of Holy Trinity Choir, in Westfield. Local soloists will augment our parish soloists to complete the roster. Max Morden, a virtuoso trumpeter whom we are fortunate to have with us for our major Feasts here at St. Thomas, will play a Handel solo trumpet concerto with the orchestra. The program will be completed by a beautiful "Kyrie" and latin "Gloria" by composer Michael Joncas ("On Eagles Wings") which I am fairly confident will be a diocesan premiere. You will all be invited to join with the orchestra in singing those pieces as well as "O Come, O Come Emmanuel." The evening will end with a reception, to which all are invited. The 300 reserved seats are available in advance ONLY, and so we hope you will use this form or call the parish center to get your tickets early, before the publicity goes out. The balance of the seating is General, available in advance or at the door. Call Parish for details. We hope to fill the church as we did last year in Montclair.
