

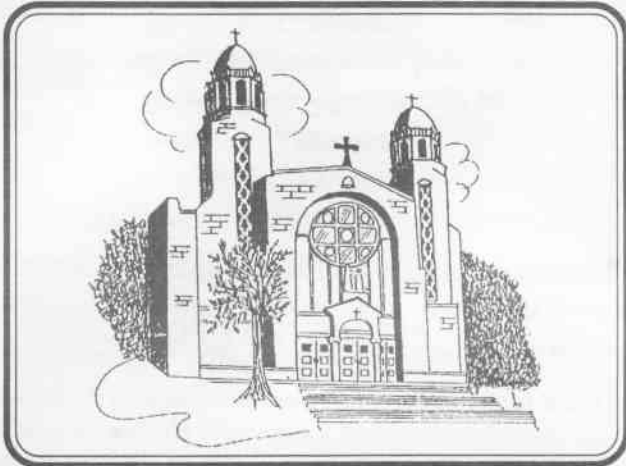

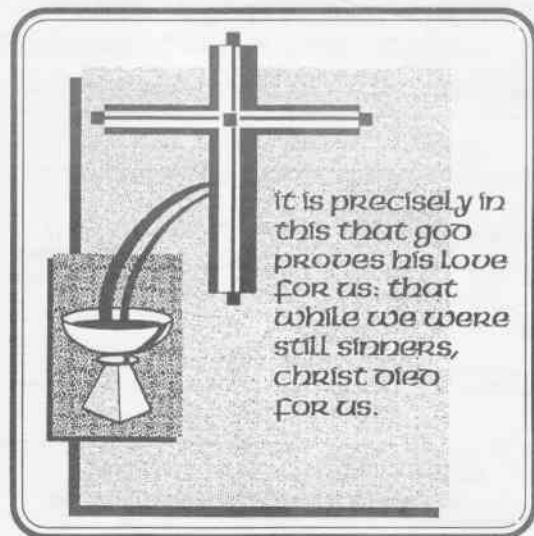

"LITURGY CORNER"

"A Better View"

Eleventh Sunday Ordinary Time

Exodus 19:2-6

*"You shall be for me a priestly
kingdom and a holy nation."*

The journey of human life crosses many deserts. For years, we await the realization of our dreams. We make sacrifices that we hope will find reward. We sense the direction we are heading, but we do not know the obstacles along the way. Looking back at the road we've traveled, we are amazed to see we have come so far. Looking ahead fills us with apprehension or anticipation.

In the desert of life, we need reassurance. We need signs that we are on the right path, that our future still lies ahead, and that God has not abandoned us.

When the Israelites crossed the desert, they approached such a place. They left one desert behind and entered the desert of Sinai. There Moses climbed the mountain, where he got a better view. God spoke to him, pointing out how far Moses and the people had come, not just in miles but in intimacy with God. God has rescued the people from danger. If they remained faithful to the covenant, they would be God's special possession.

Every so often we need that view. We need to look back for the strength to forge ahead. We discover in our past the care of God, and we build our trust in the future. Through Sunday's rest, we recommit ourselves to our covenant.

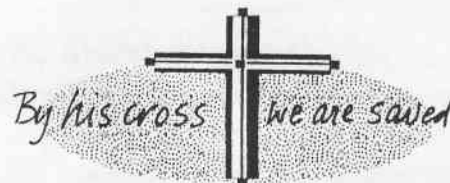
